

# Food Waste Recycling

## Frequently Asked Questions



### How to get started on Food Waste Recycling at home

**Register:** Sign up for the program with the Guard at the Recycling Center in Keasbey. Proof of residency is required.

**Get your supplies at the Food Waste Recycling Station:** You will be given a blue plastic bucket with a lid and a clear plastic bag. Each time you drop off your food waste you will be given a new clear plastic bag.

**Setting up at Home:** At home, line your bucket with the clear plastic bag. Make sure you secure the lid after each use. Keep the bucket in a secure location where animals do not have access to it.



### What can go in your Blue Bucket

**What goes in:** you can put in meat, bones, dairy, eggs, nuts, fish, fruits, vegetables, bread, tea bags, coffee grinds, bakery items, any leftovers. The food can be cooked or uncooked, it doesn't matter.

**Bucket filled?** (at your discretion) Bring it down to the Recycling Center in Keasbey. Make sure the plastic bag inside the bucket is knotted before transporting it.



### Ready to drop off

**Head to the Recycling Center** Located at 225 Smith St Keasbey

The Recycling Center is open Monday-Saturday 8:00am-2:00pm

(Closed Sundays and Holidays)

**At the Center:** Check in with the Guard, tell him how full the bucket is one third, half full, etc.

**At the Food Waste Station:** Place your knotted clear plastic bag into the lime green food waste totes and you're done.

Make sure to take a new clear plastic bag to line your bucket! Now you're ready to start all over again!
